June Marie Behm (nee Rose), of Baltimore, passed away on January 1, 2019. She was born May 26, 1931 in Brooklyn, NY. June earned her AB degree in English from Wilson College in 1953. She married George Thomas Behm the same year, and although they later divorced she raised four children who were the center of her world. June worked as a dental assistant for many years. During this time, she also worked as a freelance proofreader for two publishing companies and a production house. She then moved to Cylburn Arboretum where she worked in their offices for several years and followed that with volunteer work for them. She also volunteered in the Mt. Washington Community she so loved, working on neighborhood plantings and community watches and, for many years, organizing the annual Oakshire Road block party. June was also active in the Wilson College Club of Baltimore for decades, serving for many years as the Club secretary and then treasurer. She was an avid reader and loved participating in a local book club, hosting a meeting each year. June also loved bird-watching, flowers, travel, gardening, and most of all her friends and family.
