Adrienne Marie Schuck (2/13/1950 – 12/10/2025)

After living a life full of love, laughter, and song, Adrienne Marie Schuck, 75, died on December 10, 2025 after a brief illness at AccentCare Inpatient Hospice Center at Franklin Square Medical Center in Baltimore, Maryland.

Adrienne was the first born child and only daughter of George A. Schuck and Sarah A. Schuck, born in Shamokin, Pennsylvania in 1950. As a devout Catholic with a large extended family, Adrienne was known for her keen ability to remember all family members' names and their relationships at family reunions and occasions.

In 1963, Adrienne moved with her family from Philadelphia to Ednor Gardens in Baltimore and attended St. Elizabeth School, a non-public special education school, until 1981. For 53 years and until her death, Adrienne attended Chimes, Inc., where she was employed at various jobs and enjoyed many close relationships with friends and Chimes staff.

Adrienne was blessed with a beautiful singing voice and was one of the first intellectually disabled voice students at Peabody Conservatory. For many years, Adrienne participated in the Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks' Office of Therapeutic Recreation Services community theater program, "The Sky is the Limit." Adrienne performed in adaptations of West Side Story, Oklahoma, Hello Dolly, Oliver, the Sound of Music, Grease, A Christmas Carol and many others. She also attended many live music concerts, most notably seeing The Beatles at The Baltimore Civic Center in

1964 (with her father and many screaming fans).

Following the death of her mother, Adrienne lived with two other women at the Ridge Road group home through The Arc Baltimore. The Schuck family extends their appreciation of the loving care, friendships, and community activities provided by The Arc staff and residents during the last decade of Adrienne's life.

Adrienne was preceded in death by her parents, George and Sarah Schuck, and her brother, Michael J. Schuck. She is survived by her brothers Bernard J. Schuck, Robert G. Schuck (Claire Myer), her sister in law Janice K. Schuck, her nieces Natalie S. McEwan (Michael) and Madeline S. Destino (Elliot), her nephews Benjamin A. Schuck (Alyssa), Andrew M. Schuck and Daniel M. Schuck, her five great nieces and one great nephew, plus many cousins. Adrienne will always be remembered for her joyful presence, love of family and friends, and singing and dancing along to her favorite 50s and 60s tunes.
