Suddenly on April 20, 2013, Dr. Autumn Marie Klein, 41 years, of Pittsburgh, PA (formerly of Towson, MD & Canton, MA) at University of Pittsburgh Medical Center. Autumn graduated from St. Paul's School for Girls, Baltimore, MD, Amherst College, Magna Cum Laude, Boston University School of Medicine, M.D/Ph.D, Neurology Residency/Chief Resident, Harvard Partners Neurology Program Boston & Fellowship, Clinical Neurophysiology/Epilepsy/Headache, Brigham and Women's Hospital, Boston. She was recruited in 2011 to the University of Pittsburgh Medical Center as Chief, Division of Women's Neurology and Assistant Professor of Neurology, Obstetrics & Gynecology, UPMC Presbyterian/Magee Women's Hospital.
