



Beatrice Tracey

May 17, 1932 - September 24, 2009

On September 24, 2009, Beatrice Mary Tracey (nee Kijewski) of Rogers Forge, a registered nurse who served at the Baltimore County Detention Center until her retirement 12 years ago, died of complications from cancer. She was 77. Mrs. Tracey, who worked at the Detention Center for eight years, enjoyed serving as a volunteer at the weekly flea market of St. David's Episcopal Church, Roland Park. She was a member of St. Pius X Catholic Church. A native of Philadelphia, Mrs. Tracey was educated at Hallahan Catholic Girls High School and was a graduate of St. Joseph's Hospital Nursing School. She worked as a nurse at the Philadelphia Childrens Youth study Center, which cared for troubled, abused and abandoned children. She is survived by her husband, Francis Xavier Tracey, three daughters, Grace Anne Ridgeway of Chesapeake Beach, MD; Mary Elizabeth Tracey, of Parkton, MD; and Barbara Ayd, of Baltimore, MD; two sons, Mark Tracey of Baltimore, MD; and Patrick Tracey, of Baltimore, MD; and seven grandchildren. Also surviving are three brothers, Julian Kijewski of Charlotte, NC; Joseph Kijewski of Denver, CO; and Stanley Kijewski of Westchester, PA; and two sisters, Lillian Gill of Crownsville, MD and Mary Luscko of Smyrna, DE.
