Carrie Mae Baker (nee Simpson) of Baltimore, and formerly of Hedgesville, WV, passed away Monday, April 11, 2022, at Gilchrist Towson. She was the beloved wife of the late Robert J. Baker, Sr. (Bob).

Born in Baltimore on August 21, 1938, she was the ninth of ten children born to Viola and Chester Simpson. She graduated from Eastern High School in 1956, was married to Bob in 1963, and together they had 3 children. They owned and operated Design Lite, Inc. in Baltimore and Washington, DC for 27 years. When her children were in school, Carrie returned to get a degree from Goucher College. After retiring from the lighting business, she worked as the bookkeeper for Tersiguel's in Ellicott City, and later for the Church of the Resurrection in Burtonsville.
