



Sr. Carrie Schindler MSHH

November 16, 1931 - August 22, 2023

Sr. Carrie Schindler went home to God on August 22, 2023, at Caritas House in Baltimore; she was 91 years old and had been a member of the Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart for 72 years.

She grew up on a farm in Southern Maryland, the youngest of seven children, and spent her early years as a Mission Helper teaching religion to children and teenagers at parishes throughout the country.

In the 1990's she served as a pastoral associate at St. Matthias in Lanham, Maryland, where her ministry was focused on the elderly and the poor. In 2001, Sr. Carrie began a 10-year pastoral ministry at Oak Crest Village, a retirement community near Baltimore.

She was a lifetime learner and held a bachelor's degree in Sociology from Loyola University Maryland, a master's degree in Religious Education from Seattle University, and a Certification in Gerontology from Baltimore Community College.

She is predeceased by her parents and by her six siblings: William Charles Schindler, Dorothy Virginia Aud, Edward White Schindler, Ethel Marie Hewitt, Fr. Robert Schindler and Mary Mandzak. She is survived by numerous nieces and nephews.
