Cathy Adair Sanders, 76, passed away peacefully on January 21, 2023, after a courageous battle with Parkinson's Disease. She was born to Henry and Jane Fout on November 23, 1946. Mrs. Sanders was predeceased by her beloved husband, Brady Sanders Jr. The two were wed on January 21, 1967, after they met as "pen pals" during Mr. Sanders service in the army during the Vietnam war. Mrs. Sanders was a native Marylander. During the course of her marriage, she and her family relocated to Texas for 3 years and then again to Fairfield, Connecticut during the 1980's. After she was widowed, she moved back to her home state to be close to her family.

She is survived by her 2 children, Tammy Brown and Shawn Sanders, and 5 grandchildren, Brady, Meghan, Curtis, Jackson and Jett. She is also survived by her brother, Henry Bradley Fout III and her sister, Lesley Baber.

Mrs. Sanders was a former stockbroker's assistant with Wachovia Bank before her retirement. She was an active member of Rodgers Forge United Methodist Church and volunteered for Habitat for Humanity with the church group. She enjoyed spending time with her grandchildren which gave her great joy.
