



Mr. Charles L. Summers Jr.

January 30, 1927 - July 17, 2023

Charles L. Summers, Jr of Baltimore, Maryland passed away July 17, 2023 at the age of 96. A life-long resident of Baltimore, he was born in 1927 as the only child of Charles Summers Sr. & Gladys Summers (Parsley). He graduated from Forest Park High School and later from Johns Hopkins University with a degree in Economics. He served in the United States Navy as an electronics technician supporting early radar systems during both World War II and the Korean War. Following his education and military service, he worked in a number of commercial settings where he developed expertise in procurement management. He retired as a senior leader from the City of Baltimore Bureau of Purchases with a commendation for his service to the city. He was a decades-long congregant of First Christian Church of Baltimore on Roland Avenue and a member of the Society of American Value Engineers (SAVE).

He was the beloved husband of wife Valerie M. Summers for 55 years. He is also survived by their two sons Jason S. Summers of Baltimore and Clinton T. Summers of Dallas, Texas and their spouses Staci Summers and William Moore. He was Grandfather to Caton Summers and Ainsley Summers. He is survived by a loved cousin and friend John Parsley, his wife Sandra Parsley and their children Robin Foster and Steven Parsley and grandchildren Megan Dunnigan and Ian Sterling. He was preceded in death by his wife's sister Kathy Souza and her husband Paul Souza.
