Dean Richard Koth passed away peacefully in his home on April 10, 2026. He is survived by his wife of nearly 68 years Joan Martin Koth; his children Darleen Won and Christopher Koth and their spouses, Greg and Kim; and his two grandchildren Jared and Noelani Won. He was preceded in death by his son Jeffrey and his sister Carol. Dean was born in the District of Columbia on August 23, 1936, to Ernest and Vera Koth. He earned his bachelor's degree from the University of Maryland and then worked for the Federal Government. Starting as a business analyst for the Post Office, later working for the National Aeronautics and Space Administration, and then served as a director at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission at the Department of Energy, before retiring in 1991. A lifelong sports enthusiast, Dean loved table tennis, was an avid tennis player, and later transitioned to pickleball. He was also an accomplished pianist who often entertained his family with jazz and classical pieces. He also had a not-so-secret passion for making strawberry ice cream, his wife's favorite dessert.
