



Donald MacArthur Peek

April 21, 1918 - April 13, 2012

On April 13, 2012 Donald MacArthur Peek (93) died in Baltimore, MD. Mr. Peek was the son of the late Jesse H. and Susan Colegrove Peek. He is survived by family in Virginia and Maine, agodson, Shipley Lucas of Hampstead, MD and by close friends. Born in Baltimore, Mr. Peek was raised in Roland Park and he spent the last 70 years of his life in the Bolton Hill. He graduated from John Hopkins University with a degree in economics. During World War II he served in the Navy for four years in the Pacific area. He served in the U. S. Naval Reserve for 20 years retiring with the rank of Commander. After 30 years in the investment business, he spent the next 15 years travelling extensively in Europe and Asia. He enjoyed playing golf and bridge, painting landscapes, entertaining and being entertained by close friends. He was a member of the Baltimore Water Color Society and took courses for many years at the Renaissance Institute. A member of Emmanuel Episcopal Church, in Baltimore since 1938 he served the church for 25 years as Business Manager.
