



Mr. E.D. Farrell Sullivan

Sullivan, E.D. Farrell passed away on July 4th at the age of 95. Born in New York, as a youth he enjoyed playing chess at the New York Athletic Club. He served honorably in the U.S. Army during the Korean War, and afterward became a longtime resident of the Lakehurst Community in Baltimore County. An avid skier, he was a member of the National Ski Patrol for 30 years, and he owned the Farrell Sullivan Insurance Agency for 60 years.

Farrell was always ready to go. He played bridge with local duplicate groups. He loved going camping, caving, and canoeing with his kids' Explorer Post. He enjoyed shopping and traveling to festivals, and could be found rolling around on the ground with the dog or with one of his grand or great grandchildren. He was his own mechanic as often as possible.

Farrell was the former husband of the late Suzanne Elizabeth Rapp, and loving father of Elizabeth Phelan (Dan), S. Katherine Gross (Don), Farrell Sullivan, Jr. (Carla), and the late Hilary Sullivan.
