Elizabeth (Betty) Theresa Hopkins, 88, of Lewes, Delaware, passed away peacefully on Thursday, June 13, 2019 at the Gilchrist Center for Hospice Care in Towson, Maryland.

She was born to the late William H. Brown Jr and Elizabeth Ebeling Brown, January 14, 1931, in Washington D.C. She graduated from Saint Anthony's High School in 1948. She married the late Charles Jesse Hopkins in 1951 and they lived in Rockville, MD before relocating to Lewes, DE in 1992 after she retired as the executive secretary to the Director of Contracts and Grants at NIH.

Hopkins and wife Linda and Tiffany White of Florida as well as six great grandchildren and one great-great grandchild. She is also preceded in death by her sister Dorothy Krute and brother William H. Brown III.
