Elizabeth "Beth" M. Zimmerman (née Dolde) died peacefully on March 7, 2024.

Beth was born on April 25, 1934 in Camden, New Jersey and grew up in Haddonfield, NJ. She received a bachelor's degree in psychology from Ursinus College, and a master's degree in Therapeutic Recreation from Penn State. She worked for Pennsylvania state psychiatric institutes in Norristown, Philadelphia, and Haverford, PA. Beth was an artist, and has blessed her family and friends with numerous oil and watercolor paintings and ceramics. She was a painting instructor at the Markeim Art Center in Haddonfield, NJ. Beth loved her husband Jack, her family and friends, her cats, and arts and artwork. Beth immediately made new friends everywhere she went. She spent many wonderful times with family and friends enjoying the sun and sand of the south Jersey shore towns. In later years she moved from New Jersey to join her sister and brother-in-law at Broadmead, in Cockeysville, MD.

She is predeceased by her husband Jack S. Zimmerman, her parents William J. Dolde and Martha (Miller) Dolde, and her sister Sarah C. "Sally-lyn" Duff. She is survived by her nephew Robert "Bob" Duff (Anne Gilbert), niece Carolyn Gibbs (Bob), nephew James "Jim" Duff (Amparo), and the nieces and nephews of her late husband, in the Satteson and Heimbach families. She is also survived by numerous cousins, grandnieces and grandnephews and two

great-grandnieces, and by her dear companion, Willow the cat.
