On March 4, 2014, Elmer "Al" Jerome Blair; beloved husband of the late Patricia Ann (nee Hulsman) Blair; devoted father of Shawn Blair and Michael Blair and his wife Suzanne Blair; dear brother of Rose Cornell and the late Kate Sands, Ann Darby, Gertrude Abrahams, Leo, Edward, William, Michael and Raymond Blair; loving grandfather of Brynn Blair. Also survived by many nieces and nephews.

Born at the family home, site of the current Senator Theater, "Al" Blair, the youngest of ten children went on to graduate from Calvert Hall College, serve in the U.S. army and worked for the business started by his father for sixty-eight years. He managed the business, whose clients include the Johns Hopkins Hospital, Kennedy Krieger Institute, Johns Hopkins University and JHU's Applied Physics Laboratory, for forty years with his brother Raymond. His wife of forty-nine years, the former Patricia Hulsman died in 2008. During Al's leadership, the company was awarded several honors including the ASC Award of Excellence for General Contractors and the ABC award for outstanding project of the year.

In addition to his devotion to his family and work, Al was a lover of animals, steamed crabs and Notre Dame Football. He was a parishioner of the Church of the Immaculate Conception for fifty-five years.
