



Mrs. Frances Trimble

July 12, 1918 - October 19, 2012

Dr. Frances Hartley Trimble died on October 19, 2012 at age 94 years, after a short illness. She was born in Sydney, Australia, on July 12, 1918, graduated from the University of Sydney School of Medicine in 1941, then trained in obstetrics and gynecology at the Royal Prince Alfred Hospital in Sydney. She married Dr. I. Ridgeway Trimble in 1945 and moved to his home city of Baltimore in 1946. She served as medical director of Planned Parenthood of Maryland from 1957 to 1983.

She is survived by her brother, Phillip H. Smith of Pittsburgh, and three children, I. Ridgeway Trimble of San Juan Capistrano, CA, Elizabeth H. Trimble of Baltimore, Edward L.
