



Mr. Francis Xavier Melocik

May 26, 1931 - February 3, 2023

Francis Xavier (Buster) Melocik, son of a shoe factory supervisor and homemaker, was born in northeast Baltimore at North Luzerne Ave. on May 26, 1931 and passed away February 3, 2023. He was educated at St. Andrews Parochial School and a 1950 graduate of Baltimore Polytechnic Institute. As a kid, he loved playing two hand touch football on the city streets. His nickname was BooBoo. He served in the Navy Air Division from 1951 to 1955, serving two years at NAS Norfolk, VA and two years at NAS Oceana, VA in VF 81, and also two short visits to NAS Cuba. He was discharged as a Second Class Petty Officer (AM2). He then worked at Glen L. Martin Co., Westinghouse, and AAI Corp, then 35 years at Crown Cork & Seal Co. working on beverage fillers in the Engineering Department. His wife of 46 years, Ann (Nip) Palmisano Melocik died in 2011 at age 80. He was a member of the Parkville American Legion.

Predeceased by his parents Henry Melocik and Teresa (Heine) Melocik and siblings Henry, Calvin Kathleen and Carmella. Frank is survived by daughter and son-in-law, Donna (Guido) Palermo, of Lexington County, SC; grandsons, Christopher and Anthony Palermo of Lexington County, SC and Vinnie Palermo of Harford County, MD; sister-in-law Joanne McClayton, of Lutherville, MD, brother and sister-in-law, Joe (Kathleen) Palmisano of West Ocean City, MD; cousin, Robert Melocik of Baltimore, MD; and many nephews and nieces and their families who loved him dearly.
