My dear Sr. Frederick Mary was my first grade teach at Mt. Calvary School in Forestville, MD in 1957. I believe that my class of 72 first grade students was her first teaching assignment. What a challenge to handle 72 six-year olds at one time!! I can vividly remember my white tag with my name and Class 1A and the little dress that I wore; we didn't start wearing our uniforms until the first full week of school! I thought about her often over the years and how she set the course for the continuing Catholic education. About three years ago, I met Sr. Iris Marie McGann at a 100th birthday party for a mutual friend. When I mentioned attending Mt. Calvary and some of my nun teachers, she informed me that Sr. Frederick Mary was living in the SSND community in Baltimore. Oh, how very excited I was. I went home and wrote a long letter to Sr. Frederick Mary and much to my delight, she answered me back. But, much to my disappointment, we were not able to reconnect in person due to her medical issues. I am truly sorry to hear of her passing but I am so grateful that I was able to connect momentarily with a woman who gave her entire life to educating children and serving our Lord.
