On Monday, May 6, 2019, James Stuart Hall, loving husband and father, passed away at the age of 69 due to complications from Parkinson's Disease in Owings Mills, MD. James was born January 5, 1950 in Cincinnati, OH to Lionel and Dorothy (Cleaver) Hall. He was a long-time resident of Easton, PA and attended Wilson Area High School (Class of 1968). He also attended Penn State University and Kutztown State Teacher's College.
