Jean Dyer passed away peacefully on September 16, 2019 at her home in Timonium, Maryland, surrounded by family. Jean was born in Baltimore, September 4, 1924. She graduated from Notre Dame High School and Notre Dame College. Later in life, Jean was an early childhood education teacher at Cedarcroft Kindergarten.
