



## Mr. Jon Eric Aumann Sr

March 2, 1954 - June 10, 2017

Jon Eric Aumann, Sr., a small business owner, died June 10 after a battle with cancer in his Towson home. He was 63.

The son of Frederick C. Aumann, a furrier, and Marjorie P. Aumann, a homemaker, J. Eric Aumann was born and raised in the Homeland neighborhood of Baltimore. He was a 1972 graduate of Calvert Hall College High School.

In 1976, he graduated with a BA in accounting from Loyola College, in Baltimore, now Loyola University Maryland.

In 1983, he married Ann M.L. Aumann (nee Loughran) at the Loyola University Chapel.

In 1972, J. Eric Aumann joined his father in the family business, Auman & Werkmeister Inc., the Baltimore furrier founded in the early 1900s. Mr. Aumann worked for, and later ran the family business with Frederick Aumann until his death in 1985. J. Eric Aumann continued to operate Auman & Werkmeister, later Aumann Furs, until 2011 when he sold the business.

Mr. Aumann lived with his wife on 36th street across from Memorial Stadium before moving to the Knollwood-Donnybrook neighborhood in Towson in 1985. He resided in Towson with his wife for the past 32 years.

Mr. Aumann was active in the local community volunteering with candidates for local and state political office. As a member of the board of trustees for The Children's Guild Institute of Maryland, he helped raise hundreds of thousands of dollars for the foundation.

For nearly 10 years Mr. Aumann served on the committee, and as chairman, for Boy Scout troop 729 where he impacted the lives of hundreds of young men. He was also the treasurer for the Dumbarton Middle School PTA.

J. Eric Aumann was a former communicant of The Shrine of the Sacred Heart Church in Mount Washington, where he served on the Parish Council as secretary. In his later years, he was a parishioner at Immaculate Conception Roman Catholic Church, 100 Ware Avenue, Towson, where a memorial Mass will be offered on June 23 at 11am.

Mr. Aumann is survived by: his wife of 33 years, Ann M.L. Aumann; their two sons, Jon E. Aumann, Jr., & his wife Bonnie Aumann of Parkville, and Andrew M. Aumann & his fiancé Samantha Valentine of Nottingham; two grandchildren, Cailin & Spencer Aumann; four siblings, Frederick C. "Fritz" Aumann III of Bedford, N.H., Gretchen Aumann-Kelley of Manchester, N.H., Kristin Heck of Annapolis, and R. Karl Aumann of Timonium, as well as many nieces and nephews.
