Lucille Ann (Lucy) Topping, 71, passed away Wednesday, May 18, 2016 at her home in the Cedarcroft neighborhood of Baltimore, MD. She was born in Boston, MA and was the daughter of the late Nunzio and Josephine (D'Amico) Masciulli. She was the loving wife of Joseph J. Topping.

Lucy was a graduate of the Boston school system, a graduate of Burdett College, and attended Towson University, with concentrations in art history and early child education. She taught at the Govans Presbyterian Nursery School. Later, she worked as an account representative at CareFirst/Blue Cross Blue Shield for more than twenty years, retiring in 2011.
