LUTHER S. SIECK DIES AT AGE 100
Luther Salmon Sieck died on January 22, 2010 at St. Stephens Green at Mercy Ridge Retirement Community. He was born April 7, 1909, a son of the late Virginia (Carter) & Henry Charles Sieck. He was predeceased by three sisters & two brothers.
He wed Miriam (Holden) Young on May 15, 1937 & they shared 66 years together before her death on August 28, 2003. They lived & raised their family in Dickeyville, a village on Gwyns Falls stream in western Baltimore from 1938 until moving to Mercy Ridge in 2001. They were faithful & active members of Dickey Memorial Presbyterian Church.
Luther worked for 43 years for Claymore C. Sieck, Wholesale Florist in floral supplies. He traveled yearly down the East coast as far as Georgia during the years as part of his job. He loved to walk & he would greet his neighbors on his daily walks. At the age of 95 he could still do a nice walk outside. His great love was his family.
