



Mrs. Mary Lee Baker Anderson

January 15, 1932 - October 2, 2023

On October 2, 2023, Mary Lee Baker Anderson passed away peacefully at her home at Broadmead surrounded by her children. She was the beloved wife of the late Julian Edward Anderson; dear mother of Victoria M. Hartwig (C. Richard) and Guy Edward Anderson (Elizabeth J.); dear grandmother of Isabella M. Hartwig, Natalie E. Anderson and Julian L. Anderson; devoted sister of the late Col. John Baker. Also survived by loving nieces and nephews.

Mary Lee was born and raised in California. After graduating from the University of Redlands, she started working for the American National Red Cross. During her employment with the Red Cross, she was assigned to various special assignments to Disaster Services. One assignment in 1957 was in the Appalachian Foothills of Kentucky where she met another Red Cross employee who later became her husband. In 1961 she resigned from the American National Red Cross to move to Maryland to become a wife and mother. During this time, she joined the American Association of Women (AAUW) and volunteered for the Cancer and Heart Campaigns, her children's PTA's, assorted opportunities at The Church of the Redeemer, and at the Greater Baltimore Medical Center (GBMC) which she remained active for over 43 years. In 1980 she started working for The Church of the Redeemer. She retired after 18 years of service only to be asked to join the staff of The Corporation for the Relief of the Widows and Children of the Clergy of the

Episcopal Diocese in Maryland where she retired after 10 years of service. She then turned to Broadmead and the Hallowell Rehabilitation and Long-term Care Services to start a Patient Advocacy program like the one she loved at GBMC.
