Dear Friend and 8th grade teacher: lied for me on report cards so I wouldn't get in so much trouble with my father and stepmother, reducing many days absent to take care of my grandmother. I was awfully sick during final exam week and missed every day: didn't eat for 7 days; She told me it wouldn't be fair to make me take the exams later, after being so ill. "You're a good girl, Mary," she said. She let the class vote to elect the May Queen, instead of the teacher deciding. "It was unanimous," she told my Aunt Jane; save my one vote which was for Bonita Miller. All the boys and all the girls (except me) voted for me: Mary Leary. I loved her. She was good to me. She let me run half the block home to check on Mom during recess time. She and all the sisters came to Mom's wake. She let me go to Maryland General Hospital with Dave the afternoon Mom cut her thumb seriously while slicing leftover lamb for our Tuesday Miss Plumber day lunchtime. She told me she loved when it rained, because she got to stay in the classroom with the students during the lunch hour and talk with them.
