Mary Gail Moran Milne, age 81, passed away on January 6, 2026. Born in Hollywood, California. The family moved to Old Lyme, Connecticut in 1953, which she always considered her home, then in 1959 moved to Baltimore where she spent most of her life.

Gail earned her bachelor's degree in government and public administration from American University in 1967. Her first position in government service was working on the rewrite of the Constitution for the State of Maryland. She went on to spend the rest of her career working for governors of Rhode Island and Pennsylvania, and numerous Maryland governors working in the areas of Health, Education and various state transportation administrations.

She cherished her friendships and held them close, just as her friends held her dear in return. A devoted fan of the Baltimore Orioles and later the Ravens, she brought that same passion to her work, her church, and her family. Reading a multitude of books, both fiction and non-fiction, introduced her and enticed her to a world of travel, with emphasis on Great Britain, which she did throughout her life.

She is survived by her devoted brother Fred and his wife Cathi, her friend and former husband Neville, stepson Arryn (Eliza), and grandsons Asher and Fynn. She has a large group of devoted friends that she gathered throughout her life.
