



## Mr. Maurice (Reece) Clifton Thompson III

Maurice (Reece) Clifton Thompson III, passed away on Saturday, January 27 2018. He was 51. Son of Judy Edge Allen and Maurice Clifton Thompson Jr., Reece was born in Bronxville, NY, where he spent most of his childhood. A graduate of Avon Old Farms (class of 1984) and Rollins College (1988), Reece was known for his athleticism, gregarious nature, and propensity for practical jokes. He was, as many recalled, “the life of the party,” and also a “sweet and caring guy.” Following graduation, Reece remained in Florida where he began a career in sales at Lanier and Harris 3M. Following the death of his mother in 2007, Reece relocated to Baltimore to be closer to his sister, Cindi Monahan, and her family. There, he worked in sales at Global Telecom Brokers of Owings Mills where his colleagues would describe him as dedicated and jovial. Despite residing in Maryland for over ten years, Reece enjoyed cheering on his New York sports teams, playing tennis, and spending time with family and friends. He is survived by his father, Maurice Clifton Thompson Jr. and stepmother Otis Thompson, along with his sister Cindi Monahan, brother-in-law, Thomas Monahan, half-sister, Julia Thompson and half-brother John Thompson, two nieces, Catherine Pope and Kelly Monahan, and two nephews, Matthew Pope and Thomas Monahan.
