Melissa "Missi" Skutch Park died Dec.8 at Gilchrist Hospice Care after an extended bout with breast cancer. She was 60. The Baltimore native was the daughter of Raphael Walter and Jane Noble Skutch, both of whom predeceased her. She was married to Weston A. Park, who survives her, for 27 years.
