



Mrs. Muriel W. Trusheim

July 24, 1917 - May 5, 2017

On May 5, 2017, Muriel Wellmann Trusheim passed away at the Blakehurst Community in Towson, two months prior to her 100th birthday. She was the devoted wife of the late Lester Owen Trusheim and beloved mother of William H. Trusheim (Elizabeth) of West Milford, NJ, Carol A. Palanker (Edward) of Phoenix, MD, and Catherine T. Miller (Jefferson) of Westminster, MD and step-mother of Ted Trusheim (Joan) of Glen Rock, PA. She is also survived by eight grandchildren and their spouses, and eleven great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Trusheim was a graduate of Forest Park High School and Goucher College and was active in alumnae reunions and other events for both schools.
