He was such a peaceful man, smiling at anything. As I am typing here, I am very sad, because since he went to USA we did not meet, but we spoke on the phone not often. When you are educated you become busy with many undertakings, hence, you lose frequent conversations, meetings etc with relatives and friends which money cannot buy. You feel very touched when you hear they passed.

I recalled a conversation with his mom, my self and Him. For some reason his mom mentioned ,Tula and Mula, he said to his mom, that she should not mention that name in front of me, that my "mouth burst", because I am going to tell everybody. That is Mosee Syria will call her son Toolsie ,Tula, and her son Moorely, Mula.

When he was courting Glory, I said to him is that the only girl you see. He said that Glory is his Laksmi, my angel, that is why non girl dont want me.

When he got married, he got ready from the Panday house at 70 Village. He wore a tie and shirt from his brother Muni who came from UK, and his cousin Pandit Bhai, was his priest. I said to him , that he should have prepared to dress properly. He said Lakshmi dont care ho you dress, as long as you are sincere. And he light up his cigarette.

I remember, his mom was living in an apartment in Toronto, myself and Rabbi uses to see her often and she would want me to take my mother wirh me also. The phone rang and it was nath and she said, "I lose Vernon, but I have 2 more Vernon," referring to Rabbi and myself.

My dear brothers Vidya, Sanand, Toolsie, Moorley, Dushanta, Mansu, and utra the sister in UK, Glory, the kids, all relatives and friends, It is sad to lose Nath a man of such unique, peaceful personality, but we must be strong, ask god for faith, he is doing his job.
