After a brief illness, Mr. Paul Douglas Hartzell passed away on September 29. He was born and raised in Rogers Forge to Herbert and Mary Hartzell who predeceased him. 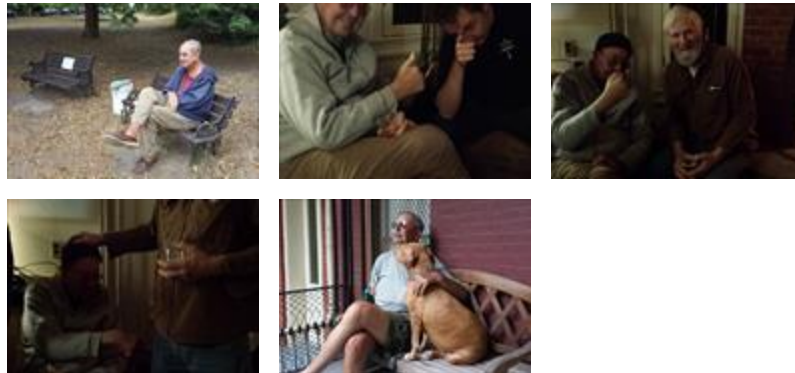
