Patricia "Pat" Elise Whitney Butler died peacefully surrounded by her family on October 28, 2025, at the Pickergill Retirement Community where she lived with her husband of nearly sixty-seven years, Edwin Franklin Abell Butler. Born in 1936, she was the daughter of Elise Bracco Bryant Whitney and William G. Whitney. Pat grew up in the Woodbrook neighborhood of Baltimore County.
