



Mr. Patrick M. McCauley

December 29, 1952 - December 28, 2022

Patrick Michael McCauley died from A.L.S. on December 28, 2022, the day before his 70th birthday.

Born on Staten Island, NY, to then-Coast Guardsman William McCauley and Anna Mae McCauley, Patrick grew to adulthood in Wyoming Valley, PA, attended elementary and secondary schools in the Wyoming Valley West School District, and had a record of perfect attendance. Academically gifted, he earned an ROTC scholarship to Penn State University, State College, majored in Biology on the pre-med track, and graduated with honors.

Immediately afterward, the U.S. Army stationed him at Ft. Sam Houston, TX, and then Ft. Benning, GA, as a Health Services Matériel Officer. Honorably discharged in 1980, Patrick returned to Penn State and earned a degree in Meteorology that led to employment with the National Weather Service in Silver Spring, MD. At the invitation of the Office of the Actuary, Health Care Finance Administration, he accepted a position as a statistician for Medicare and Medicaid Services, and moved to Baltimore

When friends, neighbors, and colleagues are asked what comes to mind when they think of Patrick, the most frequent answers are: commuting everywhere on his bicycle, his physical fitness regimen of pushups and swimming, and his home-grown cucumbers and tomatoes.

Patrick is survived by his sister Carol and her husband "CJ" Symeon; cousins

Fr. John Doris, Judy Schmidt, Sandy Martynowski, Patty Maphis, Angel McConnell; three adult children from his only marriage which was annulled, and his good friend & caregiver Gail Fennessey. His parents William & Anna Mae McCauley, Godmother Mary Lou Kern, and cousin Jackie Kern predeceased him.
