LEVERING, PAUL J., JR., 75, of Vero Beach, FL, passed away Nov 23, 2009, with his wife Suzanne by his side. Paul was born December 25, 1933, in Baltimore, MD, to Paul and Flora Levering. He graduated from Loyola High School and attended Notre Dame University. In 1953, he married Odette Cummins Levering, with whom he had four children—three daughters and a son. Paul was a member of the Maryland National Guard and worked for Commercial Credit, Avis Truck Rental, and Ryder Systems, rising to the level of Sr. Vice President. Paul's first wife, Odette, passed away after 29 years of marriage. Paul married his second wife, Suzanne Stuckey Levering in 1983, and they spent the remaining 26 years of his life together. He retired from Ryder Systems in 1989 and they moved to Vero Beach, Florida. Paul was an avid tennis player and loved fishing, particularly with his dog Snookie. He gave generously of his time volunteering with Youth Guidance of Vero Beach and the Vero Beach Humane Society. Paul is survived by his four children, Brenda Anderson and her husband Jeff, Maureen Barbato, Mary Lynn Perry and her husband Andrew, Paul J. Levering III and his wife Vicki, and his step-son Joe and his wife Leslie. He also leaves behind nine grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
