Richard Moore, lifelong Baltimore resident, died July 1 as a result of effects of dementia. He was 84.

Dick was born in 1939 to Margaret "Hootie" Wells and Dr. Alfred Moore. He spent his early years in the Waverly neighborhood. The family later moved to Cedarcroft. He attended Cathedral School and Loyola High School, where he was on the varsity ice hockey team. He graduated from Loyola in 1958. From there, he attended Loyola College, where he became president of the senior class. He then went to University of Baltimore Law School. He became a member of the Bar in 1965.

In 1961, he married Nancy Lawrence, and they had two children - Richard "Rick" Moore Jr. and Molly Moore Halleron. Dick's older brother, Al, passed away in 1997. His wife Nancy passed away in 2003.

Dick practiced law for 53 years, focusing primarily on estate planning and business law. He was an avid golfer as well as a diehard Colts, Ravens and Orioles fan. In his early years, Dick played saxophone for a local band at local dances. For almost 50 years, he and his family spent summers in Stone Harbor, NJ. He and Nancy enjoyed travel, golf, spending time with friends, and spoiling their children and grandchildren. Dick was often seen on bleachers watching his grandkids make baskets and score goals, and in

auditoriums watching plays and recitals.

Besides his son Rick and daughter Molly, Dick also leaves behind 6 grandchildren, Madeleine Moore, Erin Moore, Lindsay Halleron, Jack Halleron, Nancy Halleron, and Megan Moore. He is also survived by his son-in-law, Tom Halleron, daughter-in-law, Michele Obetz-Moore, and sister-in-law, Sally Lawrence.
