



Mr. Robert S. Lundquist

February 12, 1933 - July 15, 2025

Robert Samuel Lundquist (Bob) passed away peacefully on July 15, 2025, at the age of 92. He was the beloved husband of Geraldine (née Hall) and the devoted father of Robert H. Lundquist and his wife Melanie, Dr. Carol A. Lundquist, and Arthur H. Lundquist and his wife Nicole. He was a cherished grandfather to Katelyn, Kristyn, Lucas, and Simon Lundquist, and a dear stepbrother to Peter Ashton and Sister Susanne Ashton. He was preceded in death by his brother, Philip E. Lundquist.

Born on February 12, 1933 in Baltimore, Bob's early life took him across the country—from Maine to Texas—before settling primarily in New Jersey, where he received most of his education. He attended Valley Forge Military Academy and Lafayette College where he was a member of Delta Kappa Epsilon, establishing lifelong friendships with a group of brothers and families. He proudly served in the United States Army.

After his service, Bob moved to Baltimore, where he met and married the love of his life, Geraldine. Together, they built a life filled with warmth, humor, and nearly 60 years of marriage, raising three children and sharing a deep love for family and community.

Bob spent much of his professional career at PHH Group, where he was respected for his integrity, dedication, and intellect. His enthusiasm for learning and conversation never waned.

A man of quiet strength and wit, Bob had a unique sense of humor that endeared him to many. He found joy in sailing the Chesapeake Bay and spent

over five decades playing poker with a close-knit circle of friends whose bond went far beyond the cards.
