On Sunday, November 14, 2010, Sister Mary Alberta Sipperly, who joined the Mission Helpers of the Sacred Heart in 1947, died at The Villa in Baltimore County. Born in Watervliet, New York, Sister Mary Alberta worked for 12 years for the federal government in Washington, DC, before joining the Mission Helpers in 1947. She taught religion to children, trained adults as teachers and visited homes in missions in New York, Maryland, West Virginia, South Carolina, Pennsylvania, Ohio and Arizona. She held a bachelor's degree in Sociology from Loyola Maryland University. She is survived by a niece, Jean Clartone of Watervliet, New York.
