



## Dr. Susan T. Strahan

November 10, 1950 - December 28, 2022

Dr. Susan T. Strahan passed away suddenly at home on December 28, 2022 at the age of 72. Born and raised in Baltimore City she was a graduate of the Roland Park Country School, Hollins College (now University), and the University of Maryland Medical School. She did her post graduate training in psychiatry at University of Maryland and spent her professional career as director of psychiatric training for the State of Maryland, Clinical Assistant Professor of Psychiatry at Maryland and in her own private practice in Towson. She was appointed by the Governor to the Maryland Board of Physician Quality Assurance and volunteered her time there for many years. She also served as a Trustee of Roland Park Country School.

She is predeceased by her loving parents, Dr. John and Jean Strahan. She is survived by her beloved sisters Sally Strahan Matthews (Sandy), Nancy V. Strahan (Bill Blackstone), and her cherished nieces Katherine Matthews Pankow (Kyle), Sarah Matthews, Margaret Blackstone, and Rebecca Blackstone. She adored her new great niece Lillian Pankow from afar. She is also survived by many close lifelong friends and colleagues.
