



## Sr. Teresa Mary Dolan MSHH

March 15, 1926 - September 1, 2022

Sr. Teresa Mary Dolan (T.M.) was born in the Bronx, New York, and went home to God at St. Martin's Home in Catonsville, Maryland, on September 1, at age 96.

She joined the Mission Helper Community in 1943, saying she was "drawn by the spirit and mission of the Sisters." By 1952 she was teaching at parishes and dioceses in Texas, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Maryland, Canada and New York.

In 1982 she went to the Church of the Annunciation in Altamonte Springs, Florida, where she began a spirituality ministry that included introducing and teaching the Ignatian Spirituality Long Retreat. Over the next two decades she led hundreds of Catholics and non-Catholics through the Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius. She brought enthusiasm and devotion to the ministry that "opened their eyes to the deep and endless love of God."

She prayed that a vocation to the Jesuits would come from her work in this ministry, and today her prayers have been answered.

She is survived by nieces Teresa (TC) and Fred Schroeder (deceased), Margaret (Peggy) Dolan, and Mary and Jim Nicholson; nephews John and Sue Dolan, Charles and Helen Dolan; and numerous great- and great-great nieces and nephews, and cousins

Her sisters, Sr. Honora Dolan and Sr. Margaret Dolan (both members of the Mission Helper Community), and her brother Charles and Geraldine Dolan predeceased her.
