Theresa Yong Ho Choi, 82, passed away peacefully on October 29, 2021 surrounded by loved ones, at home.

In 1982, she became a widow when her husband was killed in a motor vehicle accident. She later became an accountant.

She is survived by her sisters Chong Ho and Cathy, her sons Daniel (wife Tracie) and Peter (wife Amanda), and her grandchildren Ryan, Isabella, Jamison, Owen, and Adaline.
