During the Berlin Crisis, he served in the U.S. Army in the early 1960's and was stationed near Augusta, GA. He graduated from Loyola Blakefield in 1954, later proudly serving on their directors board. In 1953, he won the McCormack Prize honoring his high school football team's Unsung Hero.

He graduated from Loyola College in 1958.
