



Mr. Thomas P. Swindell

June 14, 1936 - April 1, 2023

Thomas Parran Swindell died peacefully in his sleep on April 1, 2023, surrounded by his family. Tom is survived by his lifetime love and wife of 60 years, Patterson Scarlett Swindell. He was a devoted father and grandfather to his son Ty (Susie) Swindell and their children, Tommy and Annie, and his daughter Emily (Chas) Hall and their children, Willy and Bowen. Tom is also survived by his brother, Robert (Nancy) Swindell, Jr., and many nieces and nephews.

Born in Baltimore, Maryland on June 14, 1936, Tom was the son of the late Robert Haldane Swindell and Rachel Parran Swindell. He graduated from Gilman School before attending the University of Virginia (UVA). There he played lacrosse, was president of the Delta Phi fraternity (Saint Elmo Hall) and he was a member of the T.I.L.K.A. society, and the IMP society. He later served as president of the Maryland chapter of the UVA Alumni Association. After college, Tom returned to Baltimore, where he established a successful career in correspondent banking with Mercantile Safe Deposit and Trust Company and First National Bank of Maryland.

Tom spent many summers at Camp Deerwood for Boys on Squam Lake in New Hampshire, where he was a camper, a counselor, and a frequent alumni visitor. Tom also served as president of the Deerwood Foundation for several years. Additionally, Tom was an active member of the Elkridge Club, where he

enjoyed many years of golf with friends.

Tom's celebration of life memorial service will be held on Saturday, May 13, 2023, at 1:00 PM at The Church of the Redeemer.

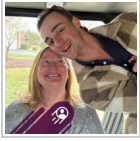
