



## Mr. Wallace "Kemp" Kemp Lehmann

August 27, 1929 - March 11, 2015

On March 11, 2015 Wallace Kemp "Kemp" Lehmann, a long-time resident of the Baltimore, Maryland area and former resident of Weems, Virginia, beloved husband of Katherine Krauss Lehmann, devoted father of William Kemp (Cynthia Renee Hershberger) of Johnstown, PA; Mary Katherine Harris (Ricky) of Manchester, PA; Karl Frederick (Colleen McGowan) of Towson, MD. Loving grandfather of Jessica L. Lehmann, Shawn L. Andrews, Emma Grace Lehmann, and Lauren Elizabeth Lehmann. Dear brother of Brent D. Kemp was the long-time President and Chairman of the CM Kemp Manufacturing Co. of Baltimore City and later Glen Burnie, as well as founder of Novatec, Inc. of Glen Burnie and industry consultant in his field of expertise. Active as a Mason, member of the Scottish Rite and York Rite, Baltimore Boumi Shrine Club, Past President of the Towson Shrine Club, active in the Royal Order of Jesters, and Past Master of Concordia Lodge (Baltimore) and member of the Lancaster (VA) Lodge.

He was an active and generous philanthropist, particularly with McDonogh School, where he attended in his early years, and Treasurer and Trustee of the Oldfields School in Glencoe, MD. He formed many associations as a graduate of Baltimore Polytechnic and the University of Maryland College

Park, and Life Member of the Terrapin Club. A devout Christian, he was a member, Sunday School teacher, church councilman, and contributor to Ascension Lutheran Church (Towson), First English Lutheran Church (Baltimore), Grace Episcopal (Kilmarnock, VA), and Epiphany Episcopal (Timonium, MD). He served in the Chemical Corps of the United States Army immediately after graduation from the University of Maryland.

Interment will be at McDonogh School, Tagart Chapel Columbarium, on Saturday, March 28, 2015 at 9:30 AM.
