



## Mrs. Weeda Louise Boyer

April 23, 1927 - January 13, 2024

Weeda Louise Boyer (nee Wilson), of Towson, Maryland, formerly of York, PA, passed away suddenly on Saturday, January 13, 2024, at age 96. Born on April 23, 1927, she was raised in Hickory, North Carolina and set out on her own for Baltimore, MD in 1945. Her strength, kindness and resilience inspired those who met her. She graciously embraced her family and friends, perpetually making new friends along the way. A loyal Orioles fan since attending their inaugural parade in 1954, she also adored her Baltimore football teams. She demonstrated her own athleticism as a professional duckpin bowler and was featured in events such as ‘Bowling for Dollars’, The Evening Sun tournament, and the Lady Baltimore Classic, where she won the tournament on January 22, 1968. Later in life she enjoyed playing bocce. She loved playing bridge with friends, doing jigsaw puzzles and word games – she was sharp as a tack. Weeda had a gift of hospitality, and her culinary achievements were widely enjoyed. She leaves us with wonderful memories of a life well-lived, a family well-loved, and a world of friendships all the richer for having been touched by Weeda. Her generous spirit during life continued in death as she donated her body to the Maryland State anatomy board.

She is predeceased by her parents, Marshall and Daisy (Knox) Wilson; seven siblings; her second husband, David “Wade” Boyer, of York, PA; and her first husband, Dale Colvin Trusheim, of Baltimore, MD. Weeda is survived by a son, Dale (Mary Ellen) Trusheim; daughters Linda (Randy) Terry, Debbie
