William Joseph Kelleher, born June 24th, 1936 in Cambridge Massachusetts, died at his home in Baltimore on September 30th, 2024 surrounded by family.

He is survived by his wife, Eva Maus Kelleher, his four daughters - Barbara L. Kelleher (Norfolk, VA), Christine E. Arthur (Tuscaloosa, AL), Heidi M. Kelleher (Spring Grove, PA,) Erika A. Kelleher (Aachen, Germany) - nine grandchildren and six great grandchildren. He also leaves behind three sisters, Anne Ream, Sheila Haberkorn, and Kathy Kelleher.

After enlisting in the U.S. Army, Bill was stationed in Germany, where he met and married his one and only love, Eva. After returning to the states, Bill and Eva relocated from Boston to Baltimore and raised their four daughters.
