



Wyatt Cameron Slack

May 18, 1928 - July 1, 2011

On July 1, 2011, W. Cameron Slack, devoted husband and father, accomplished banker and dedicated contributor to the Baltimore community, passed away peacefully at Gilchrist Hospice in Towson. He was 83 years old and a resident of the Blakehurst Retirement Community. Born and raised in Baltimore, he was an active supporter of many of the city's civic organizations and contributed generously to a number of the educational and cultural institutions. He is survived by his son, Randall Dyer Slack, daughter, Katharine Whitaker Slack, and granddaughter, Renee Slack Lamoreau. His son, Wyatt Cameron Slack, Jr. died in 1998. His second wife, Erika Muehlen Riedel Slack, died in 2007. He is also survived by three nephews, Henry R. Slack, V, Roger M. Slack, and Daniel G. Slack.
